**Item 1:** To recommend the courses to be studied or exempted for the students transferred from other colleges and joined in this college during Academic Year 2018-19.



The standing committee discussed the courses to be studied or exempted for the students transferred from the other colleges and joined in this college during Academic Year 2018-19 and following recommendations were given:

### Department of CSE

The curriculum and syllabi of the institution/university from where the students were transferred and GCE, Bargur were compared. Based on the discussion following recommendations were given:

1. As there is no much variation in the curriculum and syllabus, the members felt that the students **need not study any additional courses**.
2. As far as the course **Physics-II** is concerned it was decided to conduct a 10 hours duration **bridge course** for some of topics that were not covered in the syllabus of the university from where the students were transferred.

### Department of ECE

The curriculum and syllabi of the institution/university from where the students were transferred and GCE, Bargur were compared. Based on the discussion following recommendations were given:

1. As the students had already studied the course, "17LES306 Basic Electrical and Instrumentation", he is exempted from studying the course (Code: 17LES306) in his third Semester.
2. Since the students have not studied the course, "17ZBS205 Environmental science and Engineering", it is recommended to study the above course during his fourth semester (January 2019 – April 2019).
3. It is recommended to conduct bridge courses for the courses, Programming in C and Engineering Mathematics".

### Department of EEE

The curriculum and syllabi of the institution/university from where the students were transferred and GCE, Bargur were compared. Based on the discussion following recommendations were given:

1. As there is no much variation in the curriculum and syllabus, the members felt that the students **need not study any additional courses**.



- It is recommended to conduct bridge courses for "Programming in C" and "Engineering Mathematics – II".

**Department of Mechanical Engineering**

The curriculum and syllabi of the institution/university from where the students were transferred and GCE, Bargur were compared. Based on the discussion following recommendations were given:

- As there is no much variation in the curriculum and syllabus, the members felt that the students **need not study any additional courses**.
- It is recommended to conduct bridge course (10 hours ) for " Engineering Physics – II" to cover the topic Semiconductor Physics.
- The courses, "Programming in C and Programming in C Laboratory" are exempted from studying as the student had already studied a programming language in his First Semester.
